

REPORT on DETAILS OF LIBRARY&ITS UTILISATION

The CSTSGK library is intended to be technologically modern, well-stocked, well equipped and user-friendly. It has been trying to introduce automation of services and e learning resources through INFLIBNET. CSTSGK library is equipped with around 13,394 books in 2023-24 which were purchased under SC/ST sub plan, special fee funds and other There is a wide flexi placed at the reception counter of the resources like book bank etc., library, to display important information in the library. The library is decorated with the inspirational quotations and pictures of stalwarts of Indian library movement to educate the students. The **notice board** in the entrance of college library is used to display the jobs and other academic notices etc., has been one of the crowd pullers to the college library. In 1383 books were purchased with the special fee provision and the last 2 years nearly distributed to different departments in the institution. These books in further, will be issued to students in the name of departmental library. 5 LAN-connected desktops have been installed in the college library with internet facility. These computers are used to access various library resources that the College has subscribed to. The library allows the issue of 2 books to students, and 3 books to faculty at a time. All are encouraged to follow OER **COMMONS** for reference text books. All the staff and students entry is being monitored through different registers for time being manually also. Physical foot fall is being measured through the signatures in the daily entry registers and e.footfall is proposed to be measured in the near future after disbursing individual login passwords of recently subscribed INFLIBNET.

The library operation is going to be partially automated in 2023 as the OPEN EDUCATION RESOURCE for libraries i.e., KOHA is used on a trial basis as ILMS. The institution understands the benefits of a library management system, particularly Koha, are numerous for the benefit of college library management policy. The library uses KOHA as Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC). It is understood that, OPAC makes it easy to search for a complete library collection giving complete details of the bibliographic reference and its location in the library. A bar coded college Identity Card is proposed to be issued to the students at the time of admissions which is used for the dual purpose of a library

membership card. The barcode helps in automatic registration, check-in and check-out of books that is done by a Barcode Scanner. It is proposed to make the Library OPAC link available on the College Website. The library database can be searched through this link from any device on the campus.

The library proposes to adopt free online plagiarism software for authenticating research papers and reports in a limited version. CSTSGK is planning to link with other well-established Library Resource Centres too. Consequently, CSTSGK library members can avail e-resources available on other library systems. Recently proposals have been sent to construct a new block for Library with a seminar hall under PM USHA scheme.

SITUATIONAL ANALYSIS:

- CSTSGK library is equipped with around 13,394 books in 2023-24 which were purchased under SC/ST sub plan, special fee funds and other resources like book bank etc.,
- In the last 2 years nearly 1383 books were purchased with the special fee provision and distributed to different departments in the institution for the DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARIES.
- Local telugu news paper EENADU subscription is being paid to inculcate news paper reading habit among the students and staff and to collect news articles related to various college department level activities.
- 5 LAN-connected desktops have been installed in the college library with internet facility in the recent times in 2023-24 and OAS has been updated to increase the efficiency of the computer systems in 2024
- e.footfall is proposed to be measured in the near future after disbursing individual login passwords of recently subscribed INFLIBNET.
- The library has been renovated (glass door separation of book racks room and reading room, chairs and tables in reading block space in library) in 2023-24 with the help of individual social responsibility (ISR) supported funding through college staff assistant librarian and chemistry lecturer, office staff...Junior assistant.

OUTCOMES:

- Students and staff could get the costly and useful reference material in the form of standard text books and general books. Moreover, the recent makeover of the library is providing calm climate for a peaceful reading of books of interest by the students and staff.
- The increased physical foot fall reflects the staff and students' interest in using the library resources for their academic benefit.
- Reading habit is inculcated in turn to enrich the young minds.
- Students could participate in District level quiz competitions held by Nehru Yuvaka Kendra and could also win 1st place at Jangareddigudem Revenue Division level in the year 2021-22.
- As a result of consistent library visits by students, they could win district level 1st place in AIDS awareness essay writing competitions held in Eluru, the district headquarters by NACO national aids control organization in association with AP state health department.
- Increased pass percentage, post graduation (PG) including central universities/Lawcet/physical education/B.Ed admissions and increased campus/off campus recruitments were also the result of college level library exposure at regular intervals by the students.
- The computer systems with wifi facility attracts the students to make them better use for their class work related online activities. In addition to this, the systems are also benefitting in the form of **automation of library**.
- Online access to various journals and other e resource would be the need of the hour for the generation next students with the enhanced wifi access points in the campus especially in library.
- The concepts like professional/social ethics, moral values, service oriented mindset have been introduced with the help of different autobiographies, freedom struggle related books and books related to culture etc.,
- The acquired knowledge through vast reading has been useful in the students' class seminar presentations and internship related, community service project related surveys/questionnaire administration in rural areas.
- Students could understand the OER, anti plagiarism, e.books concepts.


