

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Analysis Report for Student Feedback, 2021-22

The feedback collected from students for the academic year 2021-22 focused on several key areas of teaching effectiveness. This report analyzes the feedback and outlines the actions taken based on the responses.

Analysis

The majority of students rated the efforts to cover the syllabus as good. Only a small fraction found it average. The clarity of expression is well-regarded, majority of the students rating it as good. However, there's room for improvement to address the needs of the students who rated it as average. While the majority of students found the use of teaching models and aids to be good, a noticeable number of students rated it as average, indicating a need for enhancement in this area. A significant portion of students rated the level of the latest developments in the subject as average, suggesting a gap in integrating current advancements into the curriculum. The use of diverse teaching methods is well-received, with majority of the students rating it as good. However, there's a small percentage of students who found it average. For the question on aptitude shown in arranging field visits, Invited Lecturers, etc. they expressed that this area needs for improvement since a significant number of the students rated it as average. This indicates that students desire more engaging and interactive learning experiences outside the traditional classroom.
